[DP] Rules for which the penalty may, at the discretion of the protest committee,

[NP] Denotes that a breach of this rule will not be grounds for a protest by a boat. This changes RRS 60.1(a).

1. RULES

- 1.1. The regattas will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).
- 1.2. The National Sport Regulations of the Italian Sailing Federation available at the following URL applies https://tinyurl.com/SpasnFIV
- 1.3. The Rules of the World Tasar Class Association will apply (see www.tasar.org).
- 1.4. Decisions of the International Jury will be final as provided in RRS 70.5.
- 1.5. Appendix T Arbitration will apply.
- 1.6. If there is a conflict between the Sailing Instructions and the NOR, the Sailing Instructions shall take precedence.
- 1.7. If there is a conflict between languages, the English text will take precedence.

2. ADVERTISING AND BOW/TRAILER NUMBERS

- 2.1. Advertising will be in accordance with World Sailing Regulation: Advertising Code.
- 2.2. [DP] Boats may be required to display advertising and bow/trailer numbers supplied by the organising authority.

3. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 3.1. The regattas are open to all boats of the International Tasar Class that comply with the Tasar Class Rules and which shall be presented at registration and measuring prior to racing.
- 3.2. At least one crew member on each boat shall be a current financial member of a regional Tasar class association. All competitors shall comply with World Sailing eligibility rules and will be required to provide their member national authority number as part of the entry or registration process. Italian sailors shall have a valid FIV membership including the health certificate.
- 3.3. Eligible boats shall enter online at the following link:

- 3.4. An entry is not valid until paid. Online payment is required (Stripe). Entry will close on 22nd June 2025. Late entries are accepted till 6 July 2025 if accompanied by the payment of the increased late entry fee.
- 3.5. All competitors must send by 22nd June 2025, in a single file, or upload at the time of registration, the following documents:
 - Evidence of insurance with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of €1.500.000 per incident or the equivalent. Italian sailors may use the FIV Plus card
 - Proof of age
 - Parental Consent Form for those aged under 18.









4. FEES

4.1. The entry fees per boat are as follows:

	European & Worlds

- 4.2. Entry fee includes: access for each competitor to the scheduled functions for the respective events; official gadget for each competitor; free hospitality for boat and trailer (when there is room) from 7 July to 22 July 2025.
- 4.3. Entries received after 06 July 2025 may be accepted only at the discretion of the Organising Authority.

- 5.2. For the European Tasar Championships, a maximum of six (6) races shall be sailed.
- 5.3. For the Tasar World Championships, a maximum of twelve (12) races shall be sailed.
- 5.4. No more than 3 races will be sailed on any race day.
- 5.5. For the Tasar World Championships, on the last scheduled day of racing, no warning signal will be made after 15.00.









6. EQUIPMENT INSPECTION & MEASUREMENT

- 6.1. For the 2025 European Tasar Championships, all boats shall be presented for equipment inspection and event measurement prior to 12.00 Monday 14 July 2025.
- 6.2. For the 2025 Tasar World Championships, all boats who were not measured for the 2025 European Tasar Championships shall be presented for equipment inspection and event measurement by 17.00 Wednesday 16 July 2025. For boats that passed measurement for the 2025 European Tasar Championships, only changed or modified equipment or boats shall be required to be presented by this time.
- 6.3. Boats may be inspected for safety equipment and measurement compliance at any time during the regatta(s) at the discretion of the Technical Committee. A boat selected for inspection shall report to the nominated area upon return to shore and follow the instructions of the Race Committee.
- 6.4. [DP] For measurement breaches or protests the jury may impose discretionary penalties which may be less than disqualification.

7. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

7.1. The Sailing Instructions will be available no later than 18:00 on 07 July 2025 at the online Official Notice of Board at the following URL: https://www.racingrulesofsailing.org/documents/10834/event Paper copies will not be distributed.

8. VENUE

- 8.1. The regatta site will be at Circolo Vela Arco, Via Lungo Sarca 20, 38062 Arco (TN), Italy.
- 8.2. The racing area will be in the waters of North Lake Garda as per Attachment 1.

9. THE COURSES

The courses to be sailed shall consist of triangles and/or windward returns as described in the Sailing Instructions.

10. PENALTY SYSTEM

- 10.1. Appendix P Special Procedures for Rule 42 may apply.
- 10.2. Appendix P is changed as follows, P2.3 is deleted and the words 'or subsequent' are added after the word 'second' in P2.2.

11. SCORING

- 11.1. Three (3) races are required to be completed to constitute each series.
- 11.2. The Low Point System of Appendix A will be used.
- 11.3. When fewer than five (5) races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.
- 11.4. When from five (5) to eight (8) races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.
- 11.5. When nine (9) or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores by excluding her two worst scores.









12. SUPPORT BOATS

- 12.1. Coaches and support personnel may register online: https://www.circolovelaarco.com/regate (Coach Entry) payment will be made at the Club by credit card or cash.
- 12.2. The registration fee is 100,00 €.
- 12.3. Coach boat charter is available. Please contact the Sailing Club Office Circolo Vela Arco per email: amministrazione@circolovelaarco.com (ONLY FOR COACH BOAT CHARTER)
- 12.4. All coach boats shall be registered.
- 12.5. All Support Boats and crews with assistance boat shall be accredited with the Local Organising Authority and shall have:
 - VHF on board.
 - accepted the "rules for support personnel and assistance boats" described in the Sailing Instructions;
 - provided numbers of the accompanied competitors.
 - A maximum of two support persons on board the motorboat;

Accredited Support Persons will be subject to the technical and disciplinary directives of the RC and the PC which, in the event of an infringement, will be able to act on the basis of rule 64.5 of the RRS

12.6. [DP] Team Managers, coaches, and other support personnel shall keep more than 100 metres clear of any competitor whilst they are racing or the inside of the course as defined by the marks of the course between the preparatory signal and the finish of the last boat in a race, except in boats provided by the Organising Authority or when asked to assist by the Race Committee.

Motorboats are generally prohibited in the Northern part of Lake Garda. For this event a temporary permit shall be issued.

- 12.7. The permit may be issued only if the following documents have been uploaded on the coach entry page, sent per email or delivered personally to the race office:
 - a. engine registration document of the rib (engine brand name engine serial number);
 - b. current insurance of the engine;
 - c. driver's identity document or navigation license, if the engine is 40.8 HP or more.
- 12.8. Each support person vessel shall display the proper yellow flag with a black S, provided by the Club. For the flag a refundable deposit of 20,00 € will be required.

[DP] Identifying marks (flags, stickers, etc.), if provided by the OC, must be visible throughout the races.

13. RADIO COMMUNICATION

[DP] Except in an emergency, a boat that is racing shall not make voice or data transmissions and shall not receive voice or data communication that is not available to all boats.









14. PRIZES

- 14.1. Prizes for the 2025 European Tasar Championships will be awarded as follows where there are five or more eligible entrants:
 - 14.1.1. Top 6 places overall
 - 14.1.2. Apprentice Masters Champion (combined age of 60 years to 79 years)
 - 14.1.3. Masters Champion (combined age of 80 years to 99 years)
 - 14.1.4. Grand Masters Champion (combined age of 100 to 119 years)
 - 14.1.5. Super Grand Masters Champion (combined age of 120 years or more)
 - 14.1.6. First Female Helm
 - 14.1.7. First Youth Helm (helm is 21 years or younger)
- 14.2. Prizes for the 2025 Tasar World Championships will be awarded as follows where there are five or more eligible entrants:
 - 14.2.1. Top 6 places overall
 - 14.2.2. Apprentice Masters Champion (combined age of 60 years to 79 years)
 - 14.2.3. Masters Champion (combined age of 80 years to 99 years)
 - 14.2.4. Grand Masters Champion (combined age of 100 to 119 years)
 - 14.2.5. Super Grand Masters Champion (combined age of 120 years or more)
 - 14.2.6. First Female Helm
 - 14.2.7. First Youth Helm (helm is 21 years or younger)
- 14.3. The prizes related to age are awarded when the combined age of the crew complies with the age conditions in all races carried out and when there is a minimum of five entrants in that category.
- 14.4. Additional prizes may be awarded at the discretion of the Organising Authority.

15. RISK STATEMENT AND DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

- 15.1. RRS 3 states: 'The responsibility for a boat's decision to participate in a race or to continue to race is hers alone.' By participating in this regatta each competitor agrees and acknowledges that sailing is a potentially dangerous activity with inherent risks. These risks include strong winds and rough seas, sudden changes in weather, failure of equipment, boat handling errors, poor seamanship by other boats, loss of balance on an unstable platform and fatigue resulting in increased risk of injury. Inherent in the sport of sailing is the risk of permanent, catastrophic injury or death by drowning, trauma, hypothermia or other causes.
- 15.2. Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. Neither the Organising Authority, TAV or ATC nor its in conjunction partners will accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.









16. INSURANCE

- 16.1. Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of 1,500,000 euro per event or the equivalent. The insurance policy presented at registration shall have an English translation.
- 16.2. Competitors must be prepared to supply proof of insurance on request.

17. RIGHT TO USE NAME AND LIKENESS

In registering for the event, competitors automatically grant to the Organising Authority the right in perpetuity to make, use and show from time to time at their discretion, any motion pictures, still pictures and live, taped or filmed television and other reproduction of them, taken during the period of the event, for the said Event as defined in the Notice of Race and Sailing Instructions in which he/she participates without compensation.
